## **Bruno departs Sporting News Radio**

Sporting News Radio announced today that Tony Bruno will depart the network when his contract expires in early April. His last show was January 18, but he will remain on staff for the next two months and work with SNR management on a number of company initiatives.

“We are grateful for his numerous contributions to the development of our network over the last three years. Unfortunately, our strategic objectives and Tony’s personal interests are not in alignment at this time, and we have each agreed to move in a new direction,” said Clancy Woods, President of Sporting News Radio.

Bruno added, “I want to thank all of those at Sporting News Radio for allowing me to remain in Los Angeles, and the listeners, sponsors, and affiliates for supporting the Tony Bruno Show for the last three years. There is no doubt that we provided a sports talk radio program that no one else in this format came close to delivering or duplicating,”

A search for Bruno’s successor will begin immediately. In the meantime, Bob Berger and Bob Stelton will host SNR’s morning program during Super Bowl week in Phoenix starting January 28<sup>th</sup>, and Arnie Spanier will host the program the week of February 4<sup>th</sup>.
